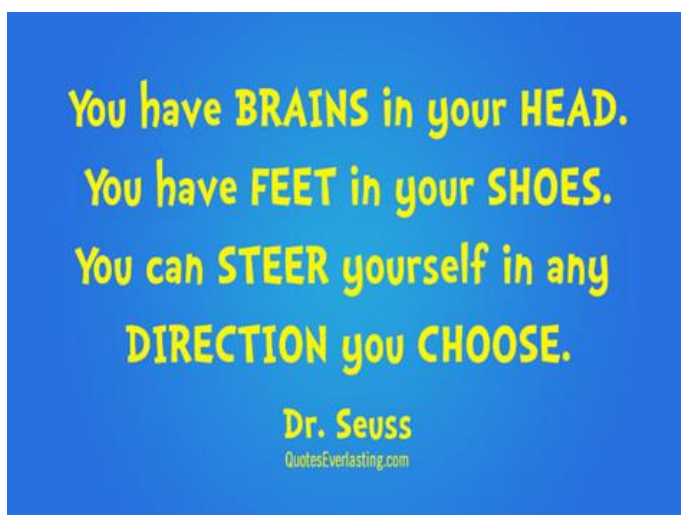

Although this is a simple message it is an important one for them to remember.
