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Ramsgate Arts Primary School: The opening of a new school - A brief summary of the journey so far...

We begin this academic year open as a 'new' Arts Primary school, housed in our magnificent, new, state of the art, premises. The doors opened on 1st September 2017 and we welcomed our first cohort of children to our - albeit incomplete - permanent school building. We are confident that Term 4 2018 will see the completion of the build and our school community can celebrate the official opening of our Free School. A journey that has not been without its challenges but one that has resulted in the creation of an inspirational, ambitious educational establishment...

'Ramsgate Free School' was a new school that opened in September 2014. It was originally proposed because of the shortage of Primary School places in Thanet and further planning for additional housing in the area would bring additional pressure to the local area and a need for school places. The school opened and spent the first two years of its existence in temporary accommodation on Chilton Primary Schools grounds where it was housed in 3 mobiles. It shared all of the school facilities.

The school was due to move to its new 'permanent' site in September 2016 (and then Jan 2017) but due to circumstances beyond the control of both the Viking Academy Trust and the Free School, the facilities on Newington Road were not ready.

Due to restriction on the current site and the consequence of trying to recruit new pupils for a school that has no building, the school end 2016-17 with 15 pupils in Reception, 24 in Year 1 and 29 in a Year 3/4 class. The PAN should have been 60 places per year group with eventual capacity of 420 pupils, this had now been somewhat delayed and has a dramatic effect on funding.

The drive to ensure the Free School remains a viable option was the catalyst for the inception of 'Ramsgate Arts Primary School'. With the permanent site location no longer in the intended 'catchment area' the core purpose for the establishment of the new free school diminished.
