We are so excited to announce the excellent news regarding our planning. We have all waited an extremely long time for the project to actually reach the planning meeting due to one hold up or another, but last week Thanet District Council unanimously agreed for the construction of our primary school on the Newington Road site. This means we will be looking at demolition in January and then the EFA and the contractors have said they are looking at completion at the end of July. When I get a revised timeline I will obviously share this with the parent council.

Moving to our new site means that we will be able to educate your children in our own open and spacious two-storey building with state of the art technology, our own recording studio, dance facilities, art room and dedicated music centre. We will also have our own hall, playing fields, school hall and kitchens. I can't wait!
