Paper Plate Spider

Supplies

- Paper plate
- Black paint
- Googly eyes
- 8 Black pipe cleaners
- Paint brush
- PVA glue







Place the paper plate upside down, then paint it black, before leaving to dry.



Thread a pipe cleaner through one of the holes, then bend it into a zig-zag shape to create a leg. Secure the pipe cleaner by twisting it around itself at the rim of the plate.



Use a hole punch to make four holes on either side of the plate, around the rim.



Repeat step 3 with the remaining seven pipe cleaners.



Using PVA glue, stick googly eyes onto the front of the paper plate.

Step 1. Place the paper plate upside down, then paint it black, before leaving to dry.
