- Good afternoon, we have recently heard from the photographers who you may have placed an order with before we went closed. This is the statement we have received from them: 'Profiles Photography and our processing lab had to close on Monday 23rd March 2020 as we were subject to government guidelines to close due to the Covid 19 virus. Unfortunately, we are now completely shut down until such time as the government allows non-essential businesses to re-open and as we're sure you can appreciate, we don't know at present how soon that will be. This meant that any orders that were being processed through our system at the time of closing had to immediately be put on hold and although we had hoped to complete the orders as quickly as possible after we collected them from the school, we did not have enough time to do so before the forced closure.
