<p><b>Task 7</b></p> <p><b>Part 1</b> – Write the opening dialogue (around 30 secs) to a stage play around a zookeeper describing the different types of animals they keep.</p> <p><b>Part 2</b> – Mime your opening dialogue from the first task and share that with your teacher (don't send them the 1<sup>st</sup> task until after you have shared the video)</p> <p><i>This task teaches that Body language, gesture and non-verbal communication are sometimes more important than what you are saying.</i></p>
