Sikhs' hair grows very long. To keep it tidy most Sikh men wear a turban. Many Sikh women wear either a turban or a scarf.

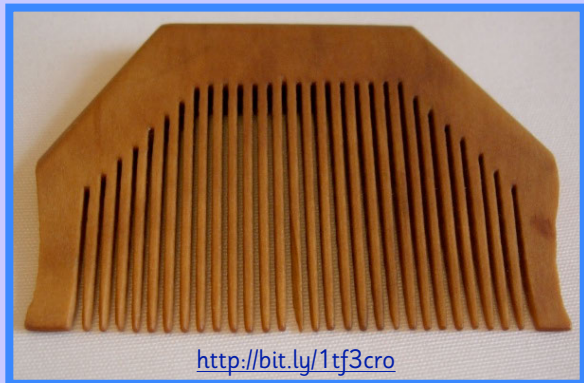


Sikhs and the kanga

Sikhs always wear a comb in their hair. It is normally tucked in near their hairband under their turban. This comb is called a kanga.

The comb reminds a Sikh of their to commitment to keep their hair and their life in order.

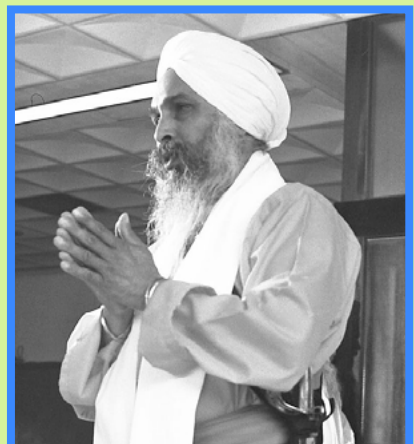
Sikhs and the kara

The kara is a metal bracelet that Sikhs wear all the time. When they look at the kara, it reminds them of God.

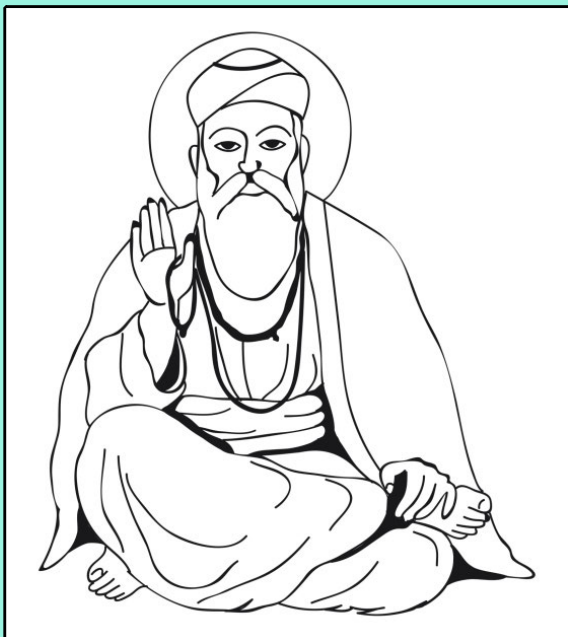

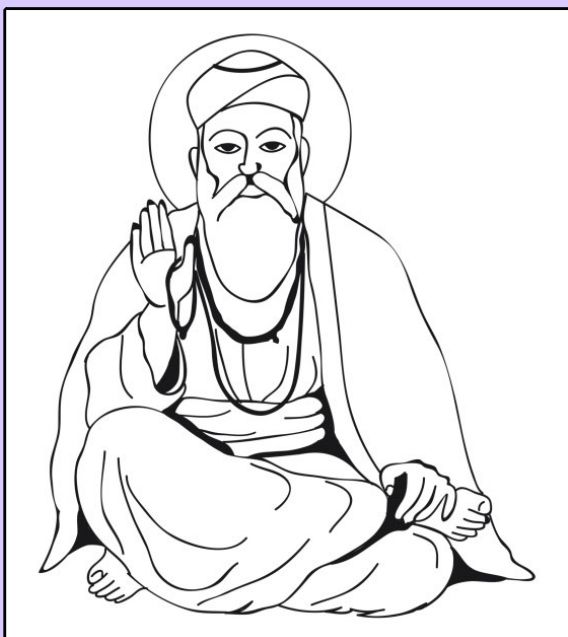
