A Mahr is a payment a Muslim man offers his soon-to-be wife. It can be money, a gift or some property. A Mahr is a free gift and is not decided by the woman.

The Nikah is the verbal contract between husband and wife. The bride and groom say a few phrases in front of witnesses; this pronounces them husband and wife.

The Walima

The Walima is the marriage banquet (meal). This can take place straight after the Nikah or even a week later. It gives family and friends an opportunity to congratulate the couple and celebrate with them.

Engagement ceremonies

Sometimes Muslim people hold engagement ceremonies before their wedding. This is called a Mangni. The bride and groom can exchange rings and a Mendhi ceremony takes place in homes. A Mendhi ceremony is where women and men decorate their skin with Mendhi paint.
