Parent Council Reminder

I'd like to take this opportunity to thank all those parents who attended the last Parent Council meeting on Monday 6th November. It was great to share with parents the progress of our building and how we will be moving forward into the New Year. For those of you who were unable to attend, McAvoy's will be endeavouring to complete the building and school grounds by the end of February 2018. The delays have been due to the Electricity Board insisting on 24hr access to the RAPS site following the relocation of an electrical substation. A compromise has now been reached and the substation will be moved in the next couple of weeks. As a result, the building work may continue and the landscaping of the school site will be able to commence, which is great. The first area to benefit from this will be the Reception outside area.

As well as raising money for the school, the Parent Council also very much wanted to be involved with the school growing as a community. We discussed that we would aim for several events throughout the year - one exciting event that has been pencilled in our diary is the RAPS Summer Festival, which we have provisionally booked for Saturday 14th July. More details will follow but if you want to be in involved in the planning of this, please come along to the next Parent Council meeting.

RAPS After School Club.

At Ramsgate Arts Primary school we hold an After School Club, RAPS Club, which is set up to provide care for children for out of school hours. We provide the children with a light snack at either 3pm or 4:15pm and at 5pm we ensure the children have a more substantial snack/dinner which we eat together. We are able to provide care on an 'as and when' basis if you do not need the club regularly, however, if your child is to attend on a regular basis, payment it advance is greatly appreciated. (Prices per session are listed below.)

During each club session, the children get to experience a variety of activities both inside and outside. All children are able to choose if they would like to expel a little energy or relax - activities therefore range from football and outdoor games, to calmer pursuits such as colouring, playing board games, watching films as well as playing on the iPads. RAPS Club is open term-time only until 5:45pm and is run by Miss Tranham and Miss Aitken, who are both currently working in Reception.
