On the day, all Children can walk around the Fayre during the afternoon (Reception and Year 1 will walk around with an adult) Home time will be 3:00 as usual, but if children are with parents/carers they may leave earlier. Entry to the Fayre will be via reception only and costs 20p per person.

On the morning of the Fayre, there will be a Santa's Grotto for Reception to Year 4 to come along to, enjoying a story with Father Christmas. Children will also receive a gift following their visit. We will be asking for a small contribution of £3 from parents to help ensure every child receives a gift from Santa. Details were sent out on Wednesday.

Genetic Moo

This week all the children across the school have been working on another collaborative project with Dreamland. Genetic Moo team have been working with the whole school to produce a collaborative digital arts project. The children have had opportunities to be involved in workshops teaching basic creative coding, 'Sprite Making', digital creature design and digital dance using Kinect sensor. The end result is that children have learnt to be creative with computers, learning simple coding skills as well as learning how to work collaboratively. The final piece of work will be given to the school as a short film with we will be able to share with our parents at school but also at Dreamland or the Turner later in the year.
